BOIL WATER NOTICE

Boil Your Water Before Drinking or Food Preparation to Avoid Illness

Due to the recent: **Routine water sample which found e. Coli bacteria in our water system** which occurred on **Friday, July 10**, the State Water Resources Control Board, Division of Drinking Water, the [San Diego](#) County Health Department, and the Bailey Mutual Water Company Water System are advising residents of [Bailey Meadow on Palomar Mountain, CA](#) to only use boiled tap water or bottled water for drinking and cooking purposes as a safety precaution to avoid stomach or intestinal illness. The affected area includes [cabins on Bailey Meadow Road and the following unpaved trails off of Bailey Meadow Road: Ivy Trail, Honeysuckle Trail, Greenwood Trail, Fern Trail, Evergreen Trail, Cold Springs Trail.

We will inform you when tests show that water is safe to drink, and you no longer need to boil your water. We anticipate resolving the problem within **2 weeks**.

Do not drink the water without boiling it first

- Boil all water for one (1) minute (rolling boil).
- Let water cool before drinking.
- Use boiled or bottled water for drinking, brushing teeth, and food preparation until further notice.
- Boiling water kills bacteria and other organisms in the water.

If you are unable to boil your water:

Household unscented liquid bleach

- For clear water, use 8 drops (1/8 tsp.) of bleach for 1 gallon of water. For cloudy water, filter through a clean cloth and use 16 drops (1/4 tsp.) of bleach for 1 gallon of water.
- Mix well. Allow to stand for 30 minutes before using.
- Water may taste or smell like chlorine. This means disinfection has occurred.

Water disinfection tablets

- Please follow the manufacturer's instructions.
